









**Output Characteristics** 




Typical Transfer Characteristics



On-resistance vs. Drain Current




**Body Diode Characteristics** 



Gate Charge Characteristics


Capacitance Characteristics






Normalized Breakdown Voltage vs.


## Junction Temperature



## Maximum Safe Operating Area




Maximum Effective Transient Thermal Impedance, Junction-to-Case

## Junction Temperature




Maximum Continuous Drain Current vs.
